1. February 25 meeting minutes

- Typo: Jean ran for President, not treasurer. Alex to correct.
- The group discussed the new meeting minutes format. There was not consensus.
 Jean puts forth a motion to approve the meeting minutes. Alex seconds it. The motion passes unanimously. The minutes are approved.

2. Board @ email summary

 - 2 emails from former director reiterating board policies and requesting corrections to the meeting minutes

■ 2 emails (from same person) asking the organization to work with the city to have bicycle repair shops categorized as essential businesses

3. Executive Director report

- Purpose: Information
- Updates on the Strategic Plan and work of the organization
- Brian focused on the Organization's response to Covid-19.
 - Office has been closed and all staff working from home. Pandemic and response poses challenges to our mission and objectives.
 - The organization worked with the City Attorney to clarify that bike shops/maintenance are an essential service. Credit to Kelsey for communicating to local bike shops on policy for sharing best practices.
 - We were really close to getting JFK closed. However the DPH and the team of health experts said they had concerns about car-free JFK drive encouraging people to congregate in large numbers.
 - All SFMTA Livable Streets employees are WFH. Timelines are delayed across all projects.
 - Our Bike Valet program has shut-down. Our SRTS program has shut-down. Adult Exercise Program can be online. We'll have a series of education courses offered online. Working to convert as many events as possible to online, including virtual townhalls. Bike to Work Day was scheduled for May 14th it will be postponed until September for a make-up BTWD. Credit to Susan Gallentine who has been working tirelessly to make the change. We are delaying the roll-out of updated membership dues.
 - When we come out the other side, I want to be sure we're in a position to have an even bigger impact.
 - The directors asked Brian questions about advocacy, messaging, and next steps.

4. Diversity Survey report

- Rahul gave a Diversity Survey presentation on the summary of results from the board and staff diversity survey in February 2020. The board and staff are becoming more representative of City of SF residents.

5. Executive Director performance review kick-off
