- Legal experience in areas relevant to SFBC's mission and work
- Strategic planning experience
- Organizational / nonprofit management experience
- Financial oversight skills (incl. capacity to serve as Treasurer)
- Personnel management skills
- Relevant connections to / representation of diverse communities in SF, particularly communities of color, families, residents of outer neighborhoods, youth, seniors
- Relevant connections to bicycle retail or industry
