

Bike It Forward Individual Distribution Priorities

This program is focused on people with limited incomes, that either live in San Francisco or, for level II those whose work or whose school is in SF. Please read through, then make a request with the link at the bottom of this page.

Priorities:

Our priority is to distribute to as many Level I riders as possible. Once those are matched, as resources are available, we aim to match level II and then level III.

Level I:

People with income that qualifies them for CalFresh, SNAP, SF Rental Assistance, Affordable housing programs, or other San Francisco focused income assistance programs.

Level II:

People whose transportation costs use a significant portion of their income present a barrier to financial stability, people who are working with little or no income, and those who use bikes as their main source of income such as delivery riders, or messengers.

Level III:

People with limited incomes that do not qualify from above. These could be earners in the 50-75% AMI range (~\$46k - \$70k for an individual), particularly single parents caring for children, or those who exhibit need to support work activities. Riders who have completed the San Francisco Bicycle Coalition's Smart City Cycling Series (Classroom, Maneuvering, Road Practice) will also be considered in this category.
