The consolidated entity consists of the San Francisco Bicycle Coalition - A 501(c)4 organization (the Coalition) and the San Francisco Bicycle Coalition Education Fund - a 501(c)(3) organization (the Education Fund).

Eligible expenses are determined by calculating the consolidated organization's distribution of each staff member's time working on Education fund's eligible work and applying this formula to the Coalition's expenses for the quarter. The majority of the work performed at the organization is for the Education Fund; political activity (endorsements, voter encouragement) is designated as Coalition activity. The breakdown is based on self-reported data provided by each staff member and is reviewed on an annual basis. The total eligible expenses include benefits, program support expenses, and operating expenses. Depending on the cash balance in the Education Fund, the Coalition will transfer up to or less than the full eligible amount.


